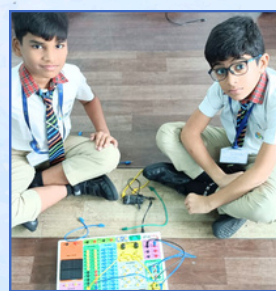
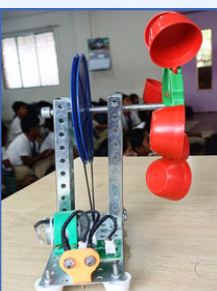

YUVIPEP IBC WORKSHOP

Hindustan International School – Guindy successfully conducted YuviPep Sessions 6 to 10 from 19th to 23rd January 2026, facilitated by Prateek, Nishanth Guru, and Baski, with strong coordination and support from Mr. Venkat and Ms. Rekha from the school side. The sessions were designed to strengthen students' understanding of robotics, electronics, sensors, and renewable energy through structured, hands-on learning. Grade 4 students engaged in activities such as the Mouse Bot maze challenge, electronic playground basics, wind and water turbine models, and assessments that enhanced logical thinking and problem-solving. Grades 5 and 6 explored breadboards, multimeters, resistors, LDR-based smart lighting, and sensor circuits, gaining practical exposure to current flow, measurement techniques, and automation concepts.

For Grades 7 and 8, the focus progressed to advanced breadboard applications including Ohm's Law, series and parallel circuits, and the use of IR, reed, and soil moisture sensors in real-life contexts such as robotics, irrigation, and security systems. Revision and assessment sessions reinforced conceptual clarity and troubleshooting skills across grades. Overall, the sessions were highly interactive and successfully met learning objectives by fostering critical thinking, technical skills, creativity, and real-world application of STEM concepts, reflecting the school's commitment to experiential and future-ready learning.
