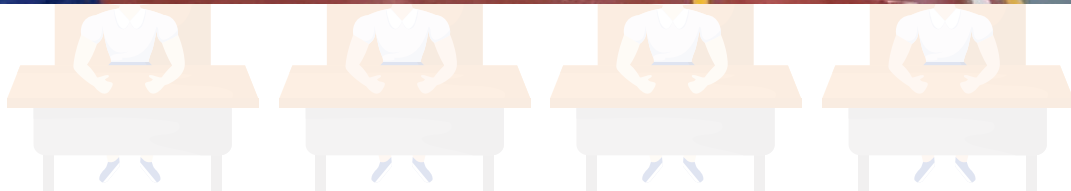




TEACHER'S DAY
