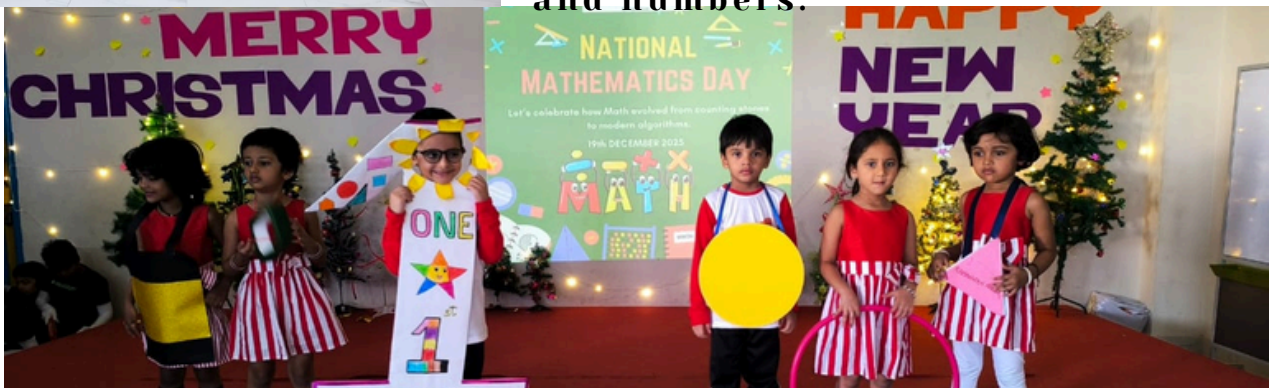
CELEBRATE NUMBERS, SHAPE THE FUTURE: NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY OBSERVED
