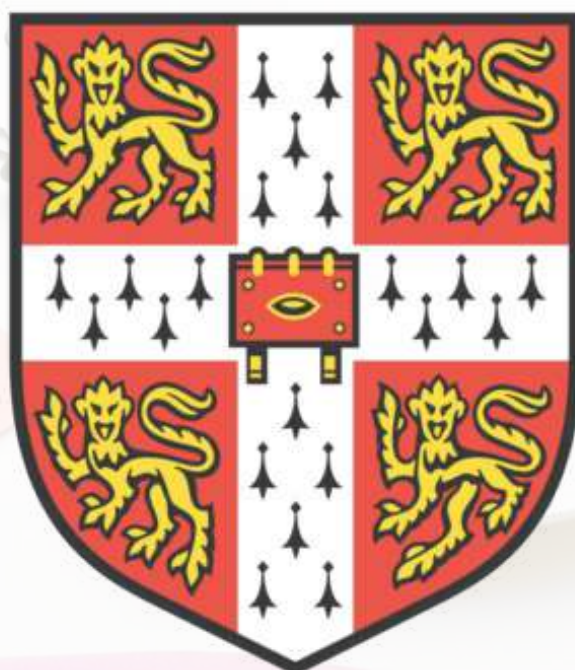

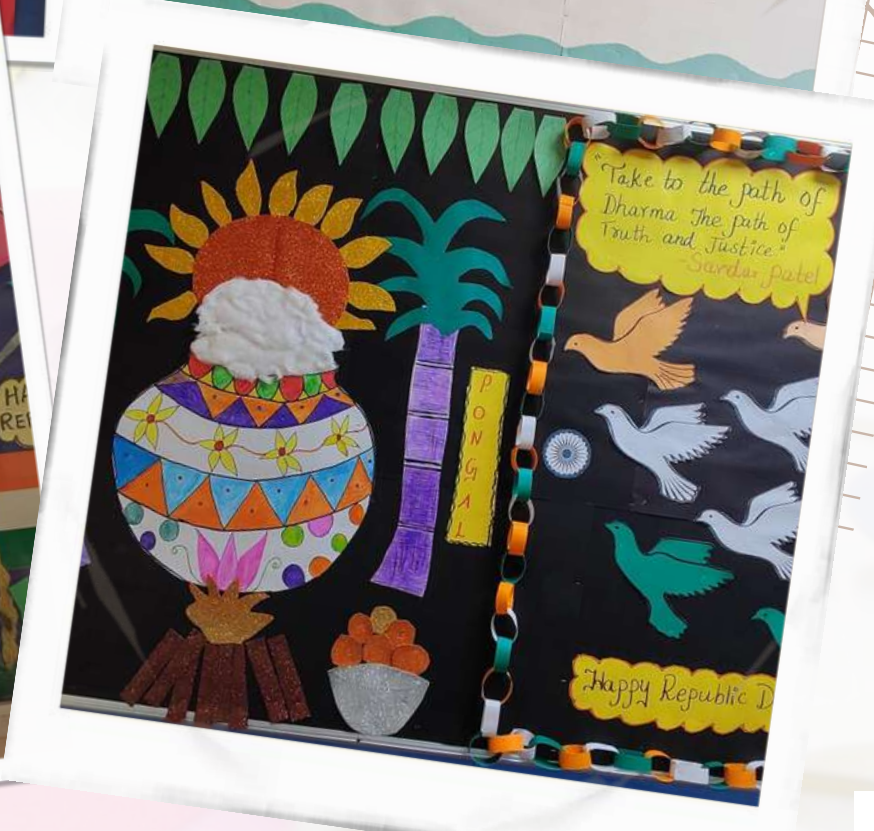
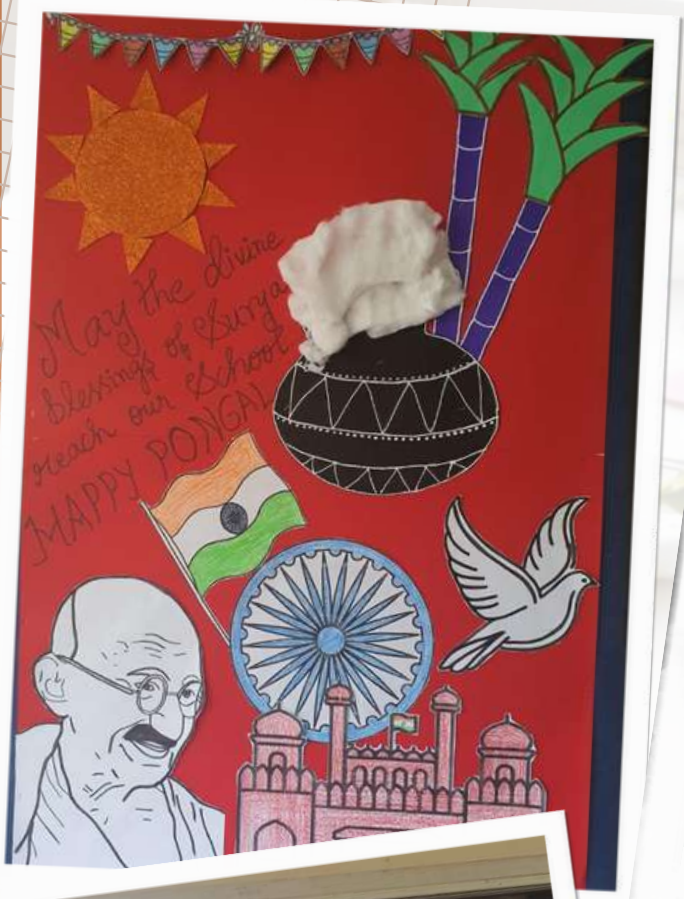
TRY TRY TRY AGAIN
