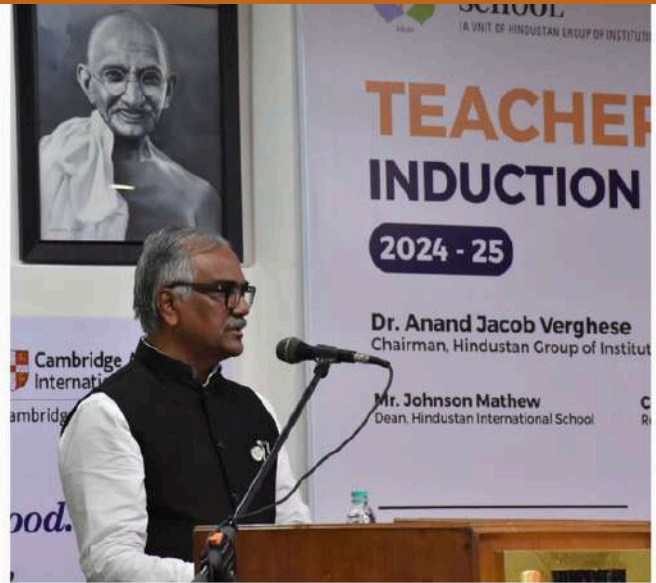
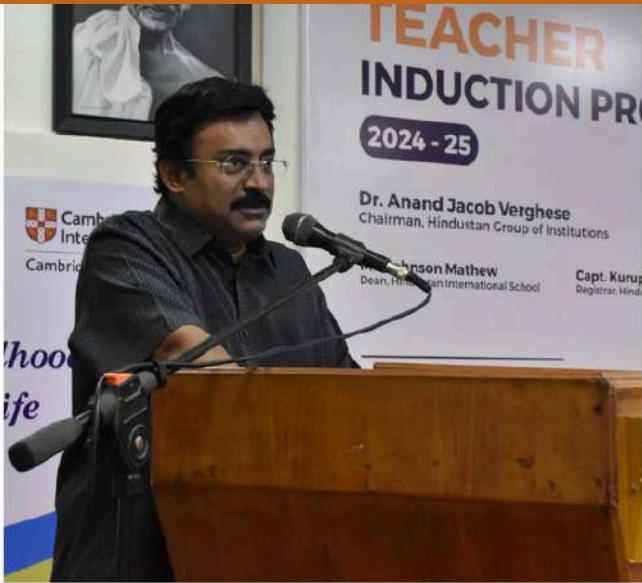

IDENTIFICATION, NURTURING AND REMEDIAL ACTION FOR SLOW LEARNERS

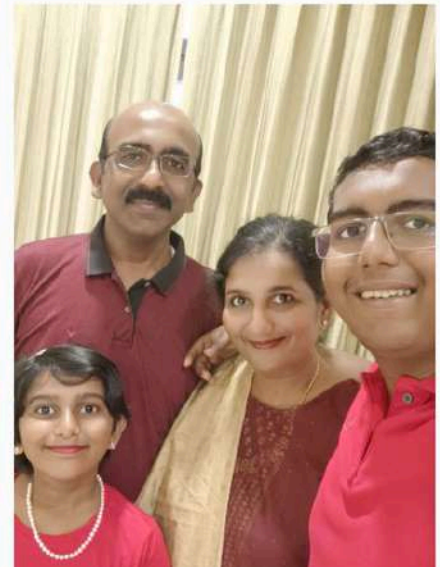
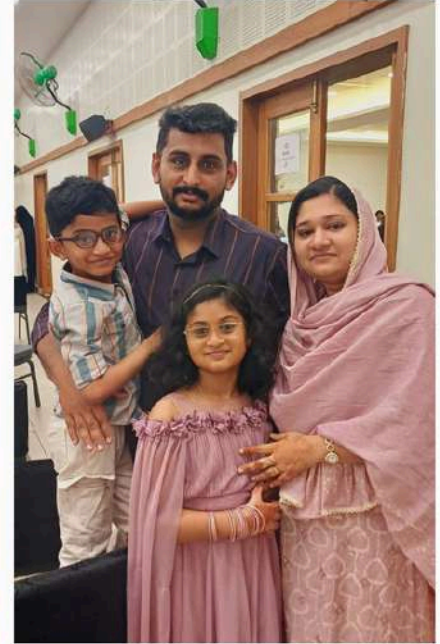
