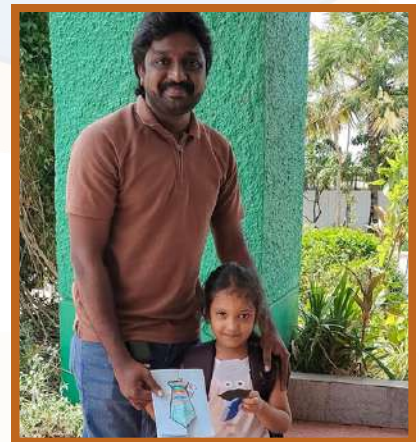
COLOUR SPLASH WEEK

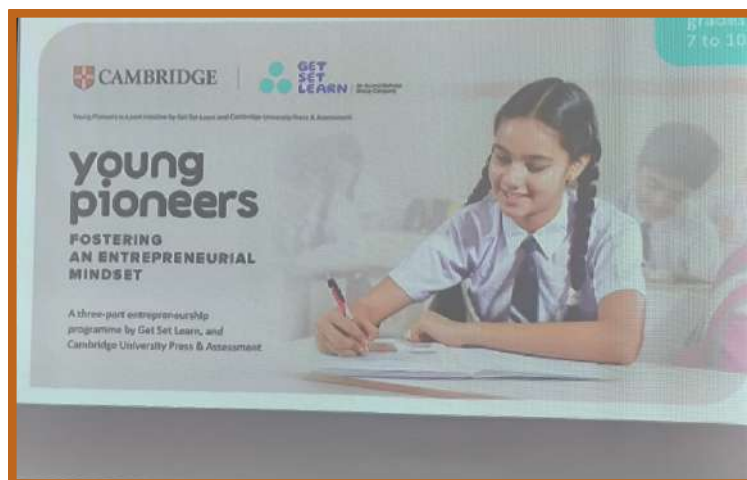
WORLD MUSIC DAY
